BACKGROUND

Morgan's of Usk Limited is a key supplier in the structural steelwork industry in the UK encompassing the design, supply, manufacture and installation of structural steelwork projects for the public and private sectors. The company operates from two permanent facilities in South Wales and this policy applies throughout the organisation, including our on-site operations.

The company operates an Environmental management system (EMS) which is accredited to BS 8555:2016, and we strive to demonstrate continual improvement regards our environmental management performance.

OBJECTIVES: Our environmental objectives are to:

- Ensure that the company actively works to prevent pollution of land, air, water and nuisance due to noise, dust or odour;
- To confirm our commitment to meeting the environmental standards expected by our customers and all current applicable legislation in the delivery of the products and service we provide.
- Ensure we develop an environmentally aware workforce, and manage our activities to eliminate unnecessary or unacceptable risk to our employees and any third parties affected by our works activities;
